Roger noted the abundance of ticks this year and recommended using appropriate repellants.

Tentative Band Assignments: Mark may use RTTY to copy the bulletin; Rick 80 m; Roger 20 m digital; Maurry 20 m SSB; Kevin 10 and 15 m

It was noted that when using multiple antennas horizontal is better than vertical Roger will bring the tri-band beam this year

Gary noted he has a 40 m dipole we could use

Will need to check if Rick will be available for FD; he is building a new house.

We will start set up at 2:00 P.M. on Friday.

Anne will contact papers and Roger will send photos.

Roger will bring a battery and solar panel so we can make at least five contacts for bonus points.

Will we need tarps on the ground underneath generators?

Discussion about GOTA and whether we have anyone to cover it; each GOTA OP can make 5 contacts for 100 points each.

Roger had several laptops and was working on getting the local network functioning.
